Eligibility

This is a Taster Event: An entry level, fun competition - where to encourage first time participation in Motorsport, participants will be deemed to be a member of the organising club for the day provided they have, as a minimum, an [RS Clubman Licence](#), but this can be achieved by completing a simple form at signing-on.

Requirements

Road legal car, Driver, Passengers, OS 1:50000 Maps 167/168, Smart mobile phone, Pen/Pencil, Humour, Romer*.

* A device to plot a map reference. If you don't have one, we'll provide one on the day.

Basic Format

There are 32 locations in a 5-mile radius of Great Leighs where QR codes are hidden. A phone app will be provided to read the QR codes. You'll be given clues to 16 of the locations at the start. Each QR code that you find will lead you to the remaining 16 locations. Points will be awarded for each code found. You'll need to find 75% of them in 5 hours to get a maximum score. There is no set route. You'll need to decide which locations to visit to score points and minimise travel distance/time. For more detail go to the [QRaken](#) website.
