D4.5.6 – Type of Event

The QRaken Navigational Scatter is a “[Taster Event](#)” (B[62], D4.5.6[80]). Permit Number: 131084.

R16.5.2 – Nature of Event

Your objective will be to find QR codes hidden in a five-mile radius of map reference TL 72888 17115 (the start/finish at Leighs village hall).

Navigational equipment required: a smart mobile phone or laptop (to use the supplied event “app”); Ordnance Survey maps 167/168 1:50000 and a romer.

R16.5.3 – Mileage of Event

While there is no set route, approximately 50 miles (minimum) will be required to visit the search locations.

Start & Finish

Leighs Village Hall, Boreham Road, Great Leighs, CM3 1NH.

All vehicles are liable to be scrutineered for adherence to Road Traffic legislation in relation to tyres, lights, wipers/washers and current MoT [if required].

Note: There will be some roads closed west of Great Leighs on the day due to a cycle race. Resolve your access to the Start by looking at [Essex 100 Cycle Route](#).

Schedule

Signing-on from 11:30 with light refreshments. All crews start at 12:00. Finish no later than 17:00. Unwind from 17:00 to 18:00 with a light buffet.

Scoring

Points will be scored for finding the QR codes. The maximum (75% of locations) score will be 100 points. There will be a 5-point deduction for each minute late at the finish. Any ties will be resolved in favour of the crew with the fewest passengers.

Entries & Classes

As a “Taster Event” - an entry level, fun competition - where to encourage first time participation in Motorsport, participants will be deemed to be a member of the organising club for the day provided they have, as a minimum, a free-of-charge [RS Clubman Licence](#), but this can be achieved by completing a simple form at signing-on.

The maximum number of entries is 20. The entry fee is £20.

Classes (Masters, Experts, Novices & Beginners) will be in accordance with the [General Regulations](#) for the series.

Format

All crews can use the phone “app” to read, display and record QR code details, navigate and access real-time results during the event – “Digital” mode; or compete in “Traditional” mode using paper maps and a scorecard.

Competitors should study the [Format](#) document, and are encouraged to experiment with the demonstration “app” before the event.
